Insurance - bad for club rides but good for Cycling UK members, see below from cycling UK website

Bad news first, In light of the latest Government advice on COVID-19, and guidance on social distancing designed to reduce the risk of spreading infection, **cover** provided under the **Organiser's Liability insurance** could potentially be **invalid** if a club or affiliated group decides to go against the advice issued by Cycling UK and arranges a group ride.

But some good news for Cycling UK members, For individual cyclists the Third Party Liability insurance included within membership will protect a member of the public against the risk of a cycling related incident involving an insured member.

However, people should not avoid cycling altogether as it remains a great way to keep fit and active and is a good way to boost immunity.

If you have joined Walsall Area Cycling but not cycling UK, sorry you are not insured through our club.
